The Strength of Catholic Education


Dear Parents and Friends,

PRIMARY POD

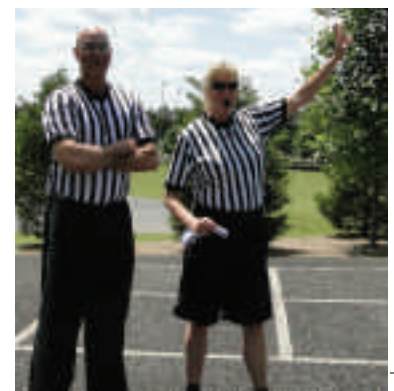

Queen of Angels Catholic School Students Break Guinness Book of World Records™ for Largest Game of Hide & Seek

On May 6, 2011, Queen of Angels Catholic School Middle School and Kindergarten students broke the record in the Guinness Book of World Records for the largest game of “Hide and Seek”.

The middle school video journalism students researched and proposed the attempt as part of a group project. The previous record was 188 “Hide and Seek” participants held by a group in Japan. Queen of Angels Catholic School broke the record with 245 participants during an hour long game held on the soccer fields. The students were also honored by the Roswell City Council.

“We are so proud of our video journalism students and the initiative they have shown toward this project. They have been hands-on from the very beginning and displayed great organization skills and enthusiasm,” explained Mrs. Erin Molter, Video Journalism teacher.

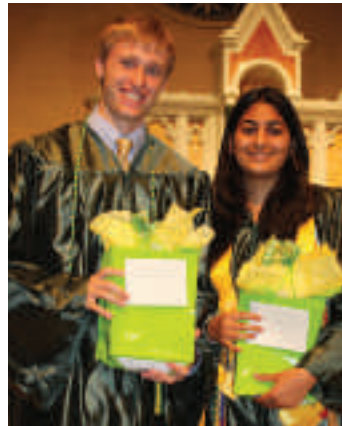
